



In Ignatian spirituality, we often hear about personal discernment. This helps us to become aware of our own experience and to make choices. But what about groups? How do we have a conversation that leads to good group decision-making? How do we identify which of a group's interactions move it toward a genuine consensus, toward more life and generosity, and which ones close the group up on itself, making it hard to resist manipulation in decision-making?

Communal discernment, pioneered by the Jesuits of Canada, enables groups to discover and collaborate with their own spiritual experiences.
