Pascale Haddad joins the Archdiocese of Montreal team as director of the Office for Faith Education

Montreal, August 25, 2018 – The Archdiocese of Montreal announces the nomination of Ms. Pascale Haddad as director of the Office for Faith Education. Ms. Haddad assumed her new functions on August 22, replacing Ms. Louise Boisvert, who will take time for a spiritual retreat before undertaking a different service in the Church. She finishes her mandate on August 31st, after serving the diocese of Montreal for seven years.

Pascale has twenty years' experience within the federal public service as director and senior advisor of human resources. She also has twelve years' experience of volunteer pastoral work in the parish, coordinating the catechetical team, developing tools and animating activities for young children, parents and young adults. She holds a Doctoral degree in public administration from *L'École nationale de l'administration publique*, a Master's degree in political science from *l'Université de Montréal*, and a faith education certificate from *l'Institut de pastorale des Dominicains*. She is currently completing a Bachelor's degree in pastoral theology.

Ms. Haddad will be playing a key role at the Archdiocese of Montreal, taking on the responsibility of supporting the pastoral regions through specialized services for awakening, initiating and growing in the faith at all stages of life. She will also assure the implementation of the archdiocese's direction for faith education, and will be responsible for running the department.
