



HIS EXCELLENCY BISHOP JUDE SAINT-ANTOINE 1930 - 2023

On December 10, 2023, the Second Sunday of Advent, the Most Reverend Jude Saint-Antoine, Auxiliary Bishop Emeritus of Montreal, passed away at Santa Cabrini Hospital in Montreal, at the age of 93. Bishop Saint-Antoine, son of Avila Saint-Antoine and Eva Vermette, and the tenth of thirteen children, was born on October 29, 1930, ordained a priest on May 31, 1956, bishop on May 22, 1981, and became auxiliary bishop emeritus on February 11, 2006.

He is survived by his sister Francine and many relatives and friends, in addition to the diocesan community of Montreal.

His body will lie in state on Friday, December 22, 2023 from 2 to 5 p.m. and from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., at Mary Queen of the World Cathedral (1085 rue de la Cathédrale, Montreal, QC, H3B 2V4).

Visiting hours will resume at 9 a.m. on Saturday, December 23, 2023, at Mary Queen of the World Cathedral, immediately followed by the funeral mass at 10 a.m.

Priests who wish to concelebrate, as well as deacons, are welcome to bring an alb and white stole. The ceremony will be livestreamed on the diocesan YouTube channel.

May the soul of Bishop Jude Saint-Antoine rest in peace and may the Lord give him the reward of faithful servants of the Kingdom.
