## 1. Diocesan roadwork of synodal and missionary transformation: going forward together!

« To see our reality and listen to the calls of the Spirit through the voices of our neighbours; to discern in prayer, in order to better serve the Lord and his Gospel, here and now. » This is the ambition of our diocesan roadwork of synodal and missionary transformation, launched in the fall of 2018.

On our journey toward this transformation, we have arrived at a new stage: discerning together the Spirit's calls to identify missionary priorities. A *Facilitation Document* for this stage, to be lived in small groups, is available on the diocesan microsite: *link*.
