## 1. REMINDER – Bishop Ignace Bourget Diocesan Award of Merit 2020

In recent years, Archbishop Lépine has expressed the gratitude of the Church for the contribution of **volunteers and groups** by conferring the Bishop Ignace Bourget Diocesan Award of Merit during the exchange of greetings at our Epiphany gatherings. Although we do not know whether this event, scheduled for January 2021, will be held in person or virtually, we nevertheless wish to **initiate the process of candidate selection**. We actively encourage you to recommend an individual person, teams or groups whom you consider worthy of this recognition based upon their activities in relation to the following criteria:

- The length of time of involvement
- Dedication and volunteer activity (giving of oneself, mutual support, empathy, peace)
- Involvement in an apostolate, such as social justice, education or prayer (faith, hope, charity)
